IPAT Minutes

March 8, 2019

II. MCTES 2019-2020 -

A. Elementary Student Growth – 3rd grade. The direction is for teachers' scores to not come back worse than last year. The concept was to look at the subgroups in iReady and to look at x% that move from one sub group to the next. The percentage used was 60% but that showed that at a significant number of schools that the student growth scores decreased. Evan will adjust the threshold to 65% and will report back to the committee. Pat asked what teachers would look at to track assessments. Teachers could track student progress using district benchmarks assessments. Trying to look at what percentage of a teacher's students showed growth.

B. Secondary Student Growth

<u>Middle School</u> – looking at using state learning gains. Using prior year FSA scores ELA to ELA. Looking at learning gain percentage. 62% HE, 5% higher than the district.

Reading – not comfortable with how certain schools were negatively impacted

Math – OK. Scores mostly improved

Social Studies – OK. Scores mostly improved.

Science - OK.

Evan will write up changes that IPAT has made.

Pat asked Evan to provide adding the district standard to see if it makes a difference. 62%, 54%, etc.

C. IPAS – tabled for discussion at a future meeting.
