

IPAT Minutes

April 6, 2016

Those present were Pat Barber, Carol Bell, Kara Carney, Paul Hockenbury, Caroline Hoffner, Randy Petrilla, Mike Rio and Dawn Walker. Also present was Sandy Riley-Hawkins, Evan McCarthy and Sarah Brown.

The meeting was called to order at 12:06 p.m.

I. Welcome, introductions and review of minutes –The minutes of 2/25/16 were moved by Paul and seconded by Randy. Motion carried. The minutes of March 14, 2016 were moved for approval as amended by Paul, second by Carol. Motion carried.

II. MCTES 2014-2015

A. Student Growth Measure Video Feedback – Strike VAM on the “student growth” slide. The VAM video has gone out to principals to share with their staffs. The videos will not be posted on the district’s or MEA’s website until the week of May 2, 2016.

III. MCTES 2015-2016

A. Recommendation for Student Growth Measures ’15-’16 – There were no changes made to the document.

B. Plan document language changes – References to district EOCs need to be revised. Teachers not classified using VAM chart – K,1,2 ESE Battelle needs to be changed to Unique Learning System – FL Alternative Assessment. Need to know process to determine rating. Assessment

For PreK and MTC the teachers do not have to get student learning growth measures, so their instructional practice score will be doubled.

AP/IB/AICE Pass rate – look at how their pass rates compare nationally and internationally

K, 1 and 2 – Reading and math

3rd grade – process – AP1 reading and math to FSA

5th and 8th grade science: FCAT Science – change to Statewide Science Assessment (SSA)

For elementary PE teachers – teach over 50% of student in school will get school VAM score based on roster verification. This applies to vocational as well.

Special areas – change to ELA and math

Classroom instructional – change to ELA and math

For plan: At schools where 2 PE teachers split students by intermediate and primary the teacher teaching intermediate will get school VAM score and the teacher teaching primary will get iReady based on roster verification.

IPAT considered adding in attendance as a factor for iReady for K-3 for 2015-2016. To do that we looked at how many days of instruction there were between the first day of school (August 24, 2015) to first day of last testing window (May 2, 2016). Evan and Sandy will build a model based on 14-15 K-2 data to see the impact of figuring in 10 compared to 15 absences and excused compared to unexcused.

Adjustment of confidence band for highly effective: Reduced confidence band to $\frac{1}{4}$ standard deviation

Motion by Carol, second by Kara. Motion carried.

IV. Planning for 2016-2017 – We made massive changes to the system last spring so a large change is not favorable. Stakeholders are still getting used to the system. However, we can survey stakeholders on content and process.
