

In an effort to clarify the language in the MOU signed on July 29, 2020, teachers who volunteer to teach more than one student schedule (hybrid, eLearning and/or 5 days brick and mortar) during their planning periods will be paid for one hour at their regular hourly rate.

If a teacher agrees to teach more than one schedule (hybrid, eLearning, and or 5 day brick and mortar), then for each added schedule, they will receive a \$3000.00 supplement, not to exceed \$6,000.00 if they are teaching all three schedules.

Co-Teaching schedule does not apply to receive the extra supplement.

No elementary specials teacher will be required to supply lesson plans to the EARNING teachers, nor will they be required to teach EARNING students.
